One of the signs of how much Greg and Diane were loved and respected was that there were at least 30 clergy in attendance and the church was full.

Before she died, Diane said that when she got to heaven she was going to ask the lord two questions: "Why is it so difficult to enter into this world and why is it so hard to get out of it?" Those are both good questions, but I think the real question for most of us has more to do with what we accomplish in between these two events. When we look back on our lives, what will we say that we said or did that had eternal significance? Did we do things that made a difference in people's lives or was it just more stuff. 
