From the Pastor:

I make it a point to get together with my old buddies that I used to work with at the treatment center. Every month we choose a restaurant in Muncie and go and eat hearty, talk big and tell lies to each other like buddies do. We usually cover the subjects of our current health status, what our families have been doing and what is going on in the world of sports. Sometimes we just observe the people around us and make comments.

On this last luncheon we noticed that one of the waitresses had bright green hair. "How do you like that color hair on that waitress", Bruce asked? "It looks so natural" I replied sarcastically. "Well, sometimes I think people just want to be noticed", Al said more charitably. It was something that didn't bother us a lot, but we felt obliged to denigrate it just a little.

There are people out there who do a lot more irritating things than that, however. On my drive home that day I pulled up at a 4-way stop sign and another car pulled up right after me. I was clearly there first, but the other car bulled his way through the intersection with no regard to my position and I had to slam on my brakes. I said a bad word and proceeded to go on a little rant to myself about how inconsiderate and self-centered some people can be.

As the day continued on I observed more people doing things that were irritating, like being impatient, intolerant and phony. I was really on a roll in taking other people's inventories.

Then I remembered what my old supervisor once told me and I had to shut up. He said that whenever you run into another person that really pulls your chain and makes you upset, you can be certain that they have some characteristic in an exaggerated way that you do not want to see in yourself. In other words, you may not be as bad as that person who irritates you, because they are obviously over the top, but you have some of that same irritating stuff in you. If you did not have some of it, they would never bother you.

That is a little tough to admit to, but true. Whenever I find myself taking somebody else's inventory, there are things going on inside of me that I really don't want to see. It is always easier to find somebody who is doing worse than I am. But it is much healthier to look at myself and ask, "Where have I been selfish, excuse-making, dishonest, prideful, resentful, intolerant, impatient and fearful?" What are the character defects that I need to work on? The season of Pentecost is the time to call on God's Spirit to help me look at myself, not others and see what needs cleansing and renewal. The inventory is mine not the other's.


